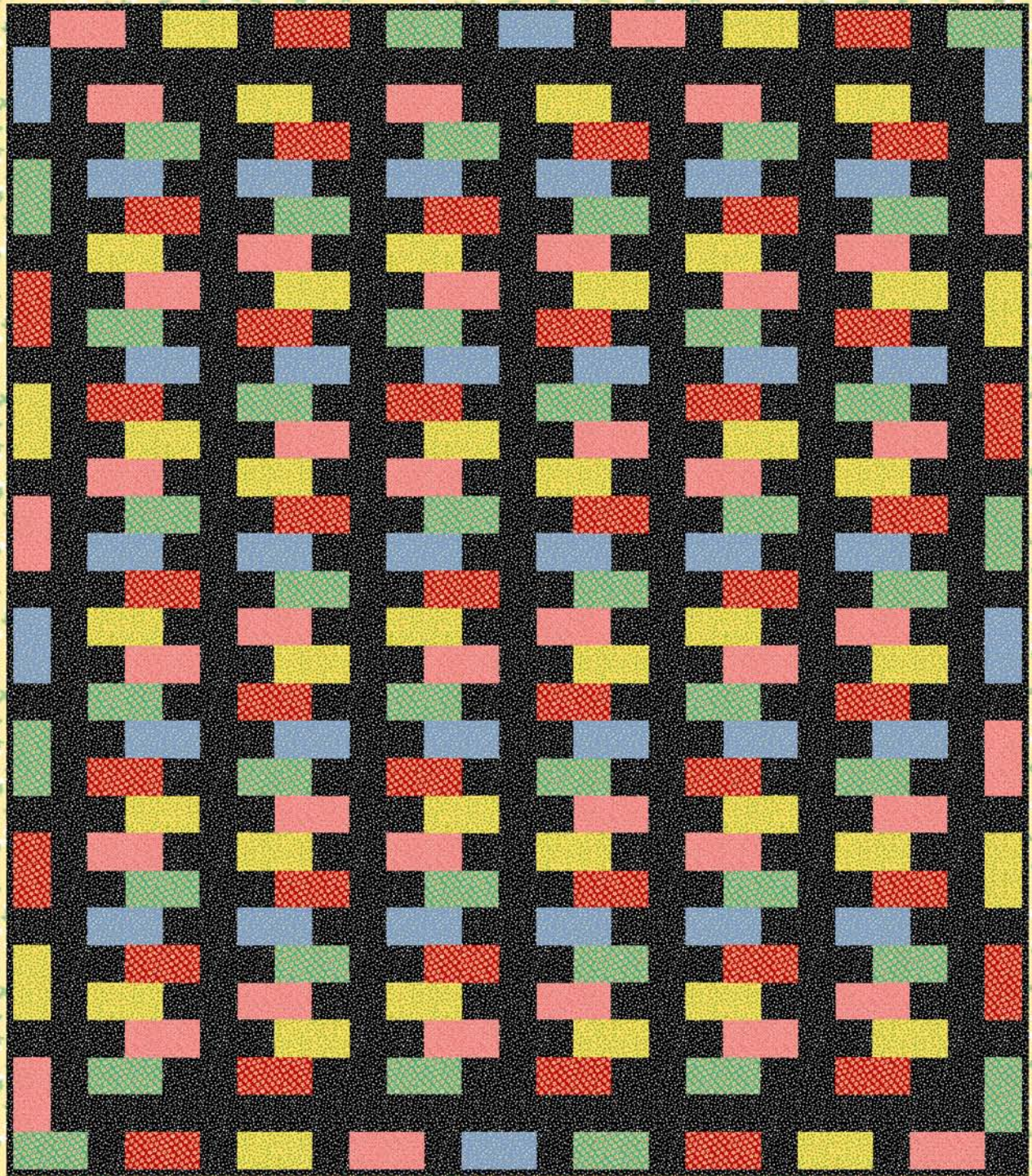

3004-3 5/8 yd.

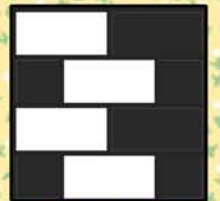
Fabric 5

# Bric-a-Brac

*Finished Quilt Size: 67 1/2" x 77 1/2"*

All strips are cut from selvage edge to selvage edge across the width of the fabric. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning the project.

## Materials

Fabric 1	Green	#3003-6	5/8 yard
Fabric 2	Red	#3003-2	5/8 yard
Fabric 3	Yellow	#3004-3	5/8 yard
Fabric 4	Pink	#3005-7	5/8 yard
Fabric 5	Blue	#3005-5	5/8 yard
Fabric 6	Black	#3006-4	3 3/8 yards

Coordinating Backing 4 3/4 yards

## Cutting

From Fabric 1, cut:

Six 3" strips. From each strip, cut seven 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

Forty-one of these pieces are used in the quilt.

From Fabric 2, cut:

Six 3" strips. From each strip, cut seven 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

Forty-one of these pieces are used in the quilt.

From Fabric 3, cut:

Six 3" strips. From each strip, cut seven 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

Forty-one of these pieces are used in the quilt.

From Fabric 4, cut:

Six 3" strips. From each strip, cut seven 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

Forty-one of these pieces are used in the quilt.

From Fabric 5, cut:

Six 3" strips. From each strip, cut six 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

All thirty-six of these pieces are used in the quilt.

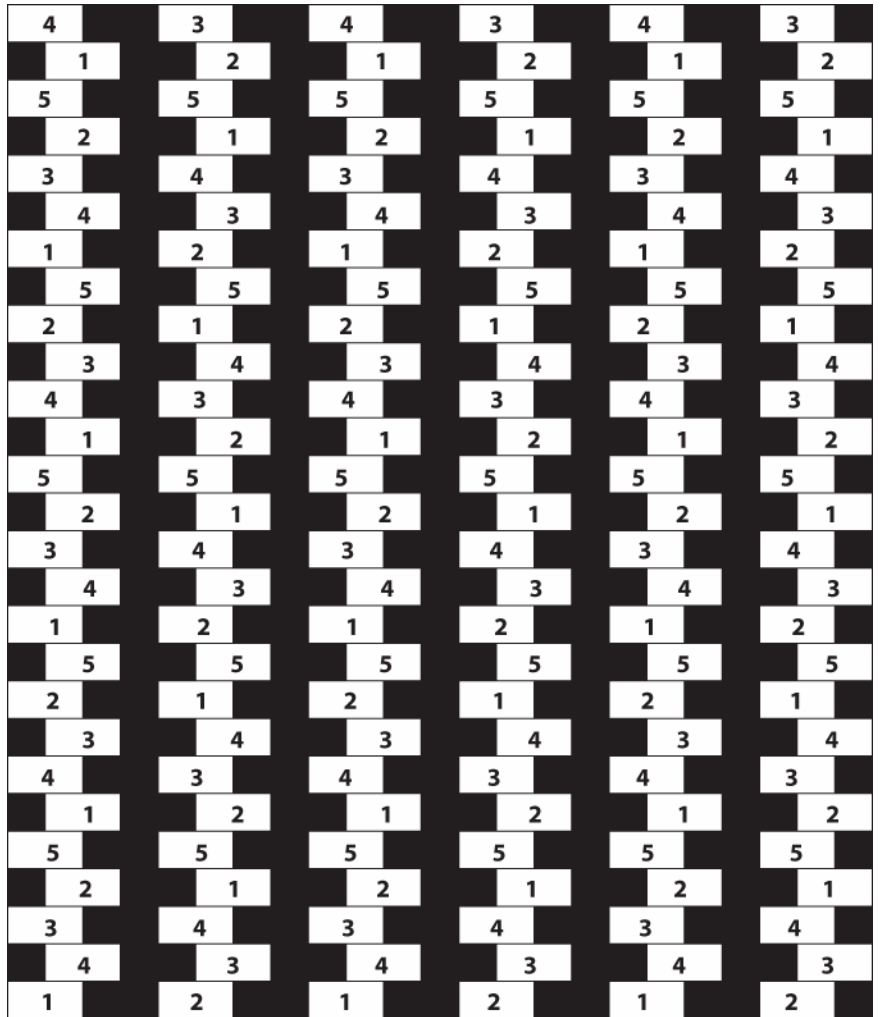
From Fabric 6, cut:

Thirty-two 3" strips. Set aside seven strips for the inner border.

From five of the strips, cut sixty-three 3" squares.

From twenty of the strips, cut one-hundred-thirty-five 3" x 5 1/2" pieces.

Cut eight 2 1/4" strips for the binding.



## Construction

The body of the quilt is composed of twenty-seven rows of blocks. Each row of blocks is made up of six colored 3" x 5 1/2" pieces, five black 3" x 5 1/2" pieces, and one black 3" square. The diagram above shows the placement of the black pieces and black square in each row. It also shows the placement of the colored pieces by fabric number. You may also refer to the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide to fabric placement. For each row, sew the pieces together end to end as shown. Then sew the rows together to complete the body of the quilt top.

## Quilt Borders and Finishing

Trim the selvages from the seven 3" Fabric 6 strips set aside for the inner border. Sew the strips together end to end to make one long 3" strip. From this strip cut two pieces 3" x 68" and two pieces 3" x 63". Sew one longer piece to the left-hand and one to the right-hand side of the quilt top. Sew one shorter piece to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border strips.

Using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide, sew ten 3" x 5 1/2" colored pieces and nine black 3" squares together end to end. Make sure that a black square is placed between each of the colored pieces as shown. Make two units. Sew one unit to the left-hand and one to the right-hand side of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the pieced units.

Again referring to the quilt pictured on the cover, sew nine 3" x 5 1/2" colored pieces and nine 3" black squares together end to end alternating the two types of pieces as shown. Make two units. Sew one unit to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top being careful to place the end with the black square exactly as shown. Press the seams toward the pieced units.

Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

Trim the completed quilt and bind as desired using the 2 1/4" Fabric 6 strips.
